# COURSE DESCRIPTION

## A132w: Ethics in Forensic Science for Supervisors and Managers (Online)

### *Learning Objectives*

This six-hour online course focuses on two main ideas: ethical decision making for individuals in leadership roles and strategies for creating and maintaining an ethical culture in a forensic science laboratory.

### *Attendees can expect to review*

- ethical challenges unique to leadership roles
- strategies to help staff maintain ethical standards
- recognizing potential ethical lapses in oneself and others

- discussing and sharing organizational policies and procedures that support an environment valuing ethical behavior
- examining ethics as they relate to social media use, cognitive bias, and modeling ethical conduct.

The target audience is individuals who work as a supervisor or manager in a crime laboratory.

### *Requirements*

Applicants must be employed as supervisors or managers in an accredited forensic laboratory.
